



2016 Sanders Memorial Cup & Kingham Trophy, and Javelin Open Regatta

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules.

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

2. Changes to Racing Rules.

The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with Rule 86 as follows:

- 2.1 For protests where only a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

3. Changes to Class Rules.

4. Eligibility and Entry.

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class that comply with their class rules
- 4.2 For the Sanders Cup, the regatta is open to a single representative Javelin Class Yacht from each New Zealand province as defined by the New Zealand Rugby Football Union – refer Class Association & clause 13.
- 4.3 Entries will be accepted at the Whangarei Cruising Club centreboard clubhouse at Parua Bay until 1200hrs on Friday 25 March 2016, by completing the attached entry form, accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 (\$90.00 for entry fee & \$10.00 for Assn fee).

No EFTPOS will be available at registration, so cash payment will be required.

- 4.4 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$20.00 may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 4.5 All sails that are new since the 2016 Nationals shall require measurement.
- 4.6 New boats may be required to submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate at registration.
- 4.7 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

5. Schedule of Events.

- 5.1 Registration:
Friday, 25th March 2016 from 1000hrs to 1200hrs, at Parua Bay.
- 5.2 Measuring:
Friday, 25th March 2016 from 1000hrs to 1200hrs, at Parua Bay.(Class Association to arrange)
- 5.3 Briefing:
Friday, 25th March 2016 at 1300hrs at Parua Bay.
- 5.4 Racing Schedule:
The Kingham Trophy warning signal is scheduled at 1400 hrs on Friday, 25th March 2016.
Race 1 of the Sanders cup will follow the Kingham Trophy
A total of 7 races are scheduled for the Sanders Cup. The Kingham trophy race will only be included in the Sanders Cup series if 4 Sanders Cup races only are completed by the end of racing on the final day.

No races will start after 1500hrs on Monday 28th March 2016

One extra race per day may be sailed, provided that the series does not become more than one race ahead of schedule.

6. Sailing Instructions.

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7. Racing Area.

The races will be held on the waters of Parua Bay, Whangarei.

8. Courses to be sailed.

The course(s) will be Windward/Leeward.

9. Scoring.

- 9.1 5 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series for the Sanders Cup and Javelin Regatta. The Kingham trophy race will only be included in the Sanders Cup series if only 4 Sanders Cup races are completed by the end of racing on the final day.
- 9.2 No score will be excluded until 6 races have been completed.

10. Penalty System.

Rule 44.1 is changed so the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty.

11. Prizes.

- 11.1 Kingham Trophy awarded to 1st place of Kingham Trophy Race.
- 11.2 Sanders Memorial Cup awarded to 1st place of the Sanders Cup Races (should only 4 Sanders Cup races be completed then the Kingham Trophy race shall be included in the Sanders Cup score, otherwise it is excluded).
- 11.3 Javelin Regatta; 1st, 2nd, 3rd place for combined Kingham Trophy and Sanders Cup races.

12. Team Support Boats.

- 12.1 Team support boats will be allowed, however their activities may be restricted.
- 12.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority by the close of registration.

Contest Information

Location.

The regatta is to be held at the Whangarei Cruising Club centerbord site in Parua Bay. It is about 20 minutes out of town on the road to the Whangarei Heads.

Accommodation.

There is no local motel at Parua Bay but there are a number of Bed and Breakfast places. The Club has cooking and showering facilities in the Clubhouse and is able to offer up to 12 bed spaces in the main lounge. You will need to bring your own bed and bedding. There are also some holiday homes and 'Book a Batch' places advertised on the internet.

Parking.

There will be sufficient room for car and boat parking adjacent to the Clubhouse and room for mobile homes or camper vans. If you are using one then advise the caretaker that you are sailing in or supporting the regatta to have any fees waived.

Security.

You are welcome to secure your boat inside the fenced compound please do not obstruct the other boats parked in there. There will not be any additional night time security in place over the weekend.

Provisions.

Nearest shopping center is further down the road towards Whangarei Heads. The Parua Bay Tavern serves lunches and dinners and there is a fish and chip takeaway opposite the Tavern

Hospitality.

The host club will not be providing lunches or operating a bar or during the contest. You are advised to make your own arrangements. The Tavern will be open for drinks and a meal after racing each day. You are advised to book in for meals since Easter is usually a busy time.
