1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

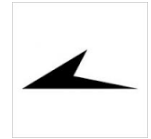
Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class that comply with the class rules and who is a current financial member of their respective Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the contest entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Javelin Nationals, New Plymouth Yacht Club, P.O.Box 576, New Plymouth.
or by emailing the contest entry form to jasonholdt@gmail.com and depositing the required entry fee into the following bank account 15-3953-0795504-00 and providing the following details:
Particulars – Boat Name; Code – Sail Number; and Reference – Surname

Completed entries and fully paid entry fees must be received by Wednesday 25th January 2017.

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 0800 hours Saturday 4th February 2017.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.



- 3.4 All sails that are new since the 2016 Nationals shall require measurement.
- 3.5 New boats may be required to submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate at registration.
- 3.6 New boats may be required to submit proof of holding a valid measurement certificate at registration.

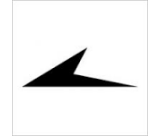
5.3 Briefing and welcome:

- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race and number of races on each day is as follows:

Day	Date	Time of First Warning Signal	No. of Races
Saturday	4 th February	1055hrs	3
Sunday	5 th February	0955hrs *	3
Monday	6 th February	0955hrs *	3

- 5.6 On Monday 6th February 2017 no warning signal will be made after 1530 hours.



6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Boats may be weighed and other measurements taken to ensure boats meet class rules and safety regulations. Any sails not previously signed will also be measured.
- 6.2 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. A safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Saturday 4th February 2017 at the New Plymouth Yacht Club.

8 VENUE & RACING AREA

The venue is the New Plymouth Yacht Club. The sailing area is on the waters off Port Taranaki

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Triangle / Windward Leeward and or Windward Leeward.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Ngamotu Beach at the New Plymouth Yacht Club.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 14.1 Ray Eade Cup awarded to 1st place in this regatta.
- 14.2 John Long Memorial Trophy awarded to 2nd place in this regatta.
- 14.3 D.F.L. Trophy awarded to the last place finisher who completes all races in this regatta.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
