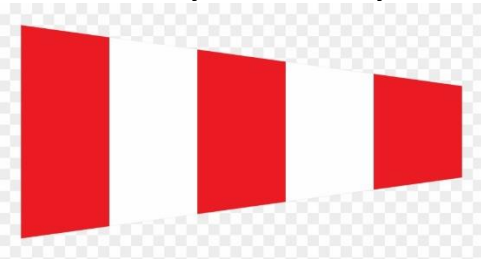
## 2020 New Zealand Javelin National Championships

### Changes to the Notice of Race (NOR 5.4):

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00, this changes Notice of Race Rule 5.4

### Advanced notice of postponement (NOR 5.3):

Race 1 of the Nationals was scheduled to start at 13:00. This race start time is officially postponed until 16:00 on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020

### Explanation and notes:

Due to the funeral of a Tauranga Yacht and Motor boat club member also taking place at the yacht club on Friday, the club rooms and many of our support crew will be unavailable until after the service at around 16:00 at the earliest. There is a chance we will be unable to race on the Friday as a result of this service. We have extended the racing window on Sunday afternoon by one hour as a precaution.

Our National Race officer for this event has also had to withdraw injured, and is now undergoing surgery tomorrow. Ben Bax (Former Javelin National Champion and Sanders Cup Winner) has kindly agreed to take over as Race Officer for the Nationals. We are working with Yachting New Zealand to obtain an exemption to the requirement of having a national race officer for our regatta due to these exceptional circumstances. The Javelin Class offer our thoughts to our Race officer for a speedy recovery.
