NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part IV shall apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) 35, 40 will be changed as follows:
 - Rule 35 will be changed to state that boats still racing but failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored “did not finish” DNF.
 - Rule 35 will further be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start, DNS
 - Rule 40 will be changed to require personal floatation devices to be worn at all times while afloat,
 - The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at 9 Ferry Road, Taupo
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the Javelin Class affiliated to a Yacht Club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.

2.2 Entries will open 1 November 2020. Eligible boats may enter by completing the application form accessed through the Lake Taupo Yacht Club website, [or by following this link](#), and completing payment of the appropriate entry fee by the closing date for entries, which is Tuesday 17 November 2020.

2.3 Late entries will be accepted until 0900 hrs on Saturday 21 November 2020 at the discretion of the organising authority;

2.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the Yachting New Zealand.

Proof of affiliated club membership may be requested at registration.

3 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with see RRS 79

4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee for all Javelins is \$60 per boat.

4.2 An additional amount of \$20 per person is payable in respect of the regatta dinner to be provided at the Club on Saturday evening.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

0830 hrs – 0930 hrs
Saturday 21 November 2020

5.2 Dates of racing:

5.3 Races may be sailed back to back

5.4 The Race Committee reserves the right to schedule one more race each day to ensure a series is completed.

5.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

5.6 The regatta prize giving will be held in the clubrooms at the conclusion of racing.

6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 Each boat shall comply with RRS 78.

8 VENUE

8.1 The regatta will be held at Lake Taupo Yacht Club, 9 Ferry Road, Taupo

8.2 The racing are will be Tapuaeharuru Bay, Lake Taupo

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

11.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2

a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

b) When 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats are not permitted

13 LAUNCHING & STORAGE

Boats may be launched from the beach in front of the LTYC Clubhouse

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

15 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded for 1, 2 & 3 places.

Spot prizes may be awarded.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
